

MARIONVILLE CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP

Saturday May 19th, 2018

Please read through this information carefully to ensure you meet the guidelines of this program!

The City –wide clean-up is Saturday May 19th, 2018 and is only for Residents inside City of Marionville paying for Trash Services through the City of Marionville Utilities, This program is being offered with the intent of providing Marionville residents the opportunity to clean out their garage, basement or closets, and get rid of old worn out items and junk.

CURBSIDE PICK-UP

- * Citizens must have their acceptable items at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. the morning of Saturday, May 19th 2018, for pick-up and are encouraged to put items out the night before as we will be running multiple trucks.
- * Any non-acceptable items that are included will be left at the curb for disposal by the resident.
- * Crews cannot access personal property to assist in moving items to the curb.
- * Clean-up will not take place at businesses, apartment buildings or at vacant homes

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Furniture – Indoor/Outdoor
- Hand and Power Tools
- Beds/Mattresses
- Clothing
- Toys
- Carpeting/Padding (Must be cut in 4' or smaller sections)
- Microwaves
- Televisions/Monitors
- Grills - NO Propane Tanks
- Small lumber projects (Must be cut in 4' or smaller sections and no bigger than 4" in diam-
- Weed Eaters / Power tools (Must be drained of all fuel and oil)

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Tires
- Home Remodeling Projects
- Brush/Limbs/Yard Waste
- Medical Items (Needles)
- Rocks, bricks, concrete
- Bulk Liquids
- Propane Tanks
- Fluorescent/CFL/HID Bulbs
- Batteries
- Appliances
- Hazardous Waste (including paint, oil, aerosol cans, fertilizers, etc.)
- No Vehicle / Large Engine Parts (Motors, Doors, Hoods, etc.)
